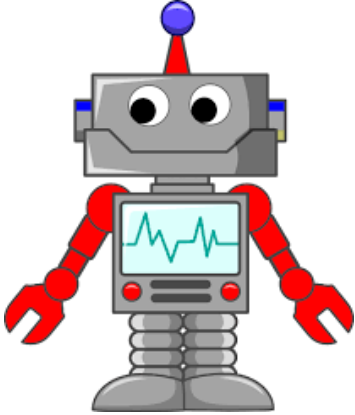


You asked for it.....we heard you! The ELWOOD SUMMER ROBOTICS program!!
